

# CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING OPTIONS

A Pap test is a screening test that can detect cell changes in the cervix that may lead to cancer before people feel any symptoms. The Ontario Cervical Screening Program recommends that anyone with a cervix (women, transmasculine and non-binary people) who is or ever has been sexually active, and is between 21-70 year old, have a Pap test every 3 years.

Individuals who are due for their cervical cancer screening, and do not have a primary healthcare provider, can get a Pap test at one of the clinics below.

## BROCKTON AND AREA FAMILY HEALTH TEAM

This is a monthly Preventative Screening and Wellness Clinic. This program provides a 2-visit series with a Nurse Practitioner and Registered Nurse offering routine screening and education. Appointments are available for individuals living in Grey or Bruce Counties without a primary care provider.

## KINCARDINE FAMILY HEALTH TEAM

This Cervical Cancer Screening Clinic runs 4 times per year for individuals living in Kincardine without a primary care provider.

## SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH CLINIC (GREY BRUCE PUBLIC HEALTH)

Pap test appointments are available in Owen Sound and Hanover. Screening and treatment for STI's are available at the Owen Sound and Hanover sites, and during monthly clinics in Kincardine, Southampton, and Warton.
