Family Doctor or Nurse Practitioner

If you or a family member are feeling unwell, contact your family doctor or nurse practitioner. If they're not available—or if you don't have one—you can **explore the options below**.



Pharmacy Services

Pharmacists can now help with many health concerns and prescribe for common conditions, including:

- **Infections & skin conditions:** pink eye, cold sores, yeast infections, UTIs, dermatitis, diaper rash, and more
- **Insect bites:** including tick bites (post-exposure)
- **Allergies & respiratory issues:** such as hay fever
- **Digestive & stomach concerns:** acid reflux, nausea during pregnancy, parasitic worms, and more
